What do objects mean in this context?

We are used to objects, but are provoked by environments.

How do we use the objects? We think we are using them but we aren't.

What kind of objects resist use? Anyway we interact constructs object, defines its use.

Does one need to make relations between objects in order to know them?

Normal to say we are familiar with objects, but untrue. We misunderstand objects.

We are mediated by objects through our relations in the non-Relation with animals.

Our bodies now have processes - i.e. they are these objects or part of us. Objects in urban environments are extensions of bodies. TIME. How is one aware one is creating a new object? HABITUAL PROCESSES - relation to performance, daily activity.
